Meeting Recap – April 4, 2017:

The meeting began with introductions of myself and fellow committee members. We kicked things off by going over the new format of this year's "auction". After research and surveys done prior to my arrival in February, it was decided that the former "Howl of a Good Time Auction" would transition into the Cherry & Silver Scholarship Gala! This year's event will still play host to a silent and live auction with a sit-down plated dinner, however it will be more of a formal event, in which we are encouraging formal attire. The decor and theme of the event will be Cherry & Silver to highlight Lobo colors and will be an elegant/formal evening for a great cause. With this change, the venue for this year's event is at the Hyatt Regency in downtown Albuquerque. Hyatt Regency has given us a great deal on the space and food and has been very accommodating to work with. Hyatt is also still within the Heritage Hotels properties, as was Hotel Albuquerque. This year's event will be held on Friday, August 18th with a similar time-frame of last year. Exact times will be announced in coming weeks.

Concerns were stated by multiple committee members regarding parking downtown at the Hyatt Regency. The staff there has been very accommodating in helping relieve these issues. They are offering 25 VIP Valet passes, as well as offering complimentary parking for all guests. I am continuing to have these conversations with them, especially regarding having another parking garage available for our use.

We then discussed some points of interest from last year's auction that people would like to change. A couple of main points were reducing "registration time" at the registration table. This could be alleviated by getting rid of bid paddles. Another topic was the auctioneer - it was decided that a new auctioneer is necessary this year. I will begin contacting people next week regarding their availability. Another point of concern was the check-out time. Shelley suggested having a concierge service that would be available for purchase for a set rate (\$25-50) and it would allow the items to be delivered to their home/office within a week of the auction. This idea seemed to go over well. Lastly, our goal for this year is to reduce the # of silent auction items but increase the value of the items. My goal would be to have most items at a minimum bid of \$100 (value of \$200). Of course there will be some items that are below this value, but we can always package things together to create great baskets, etc.

Lastly, we discussed item solicitation, item logistics, and item categories. I have put a charge out to the committee to begin soliciting items immediately. The more we can have come in now, the easier our jobs will be later this summer. The charge is to get items with a value of \$200 or more. Please note that I have a team of interns that will be soliciting restaurant giftcards, etc. This small task force will be great for smaller items. You can begin soliciting for silent auction items or live auction items. I have begun soliciting for items as well.. these include airline tickets, trips, etc. Please note that we do have 2 safari hunts in Africa already available for our use for the auction!

Once an item is secured, please let me know so I can begin tracking everything within my database. I ask that all items/certificates, etc, please to be given to me. This will allow me to keep everything locked up and safe prior to the auction.
